WHAT'S THE THEME?

Artists are asked to submit work that interprets and explores:

- * the struggles and joys of living in a diverse community;
- * the impact of prejudice and hatred on human dignity
- * the varied people, cultures and perspectives in our world.

THE CRITERIA:

Final selections will be chosen based on artistic excellence in addressing the themes listed above. Artists are encouraged to submit works relevant to Long Island. The artwork will also be evaluated on how effectively it will read outdoors when enlarged to billboard size – 16 feet wide by 12 feet high. Artists are encouraged to use bold saturated colors and strong lines. Final selections (by category) will be made by professional artists, curators and art professionals.

WHO CAN ENTER?

Long Island artists, professionals, amateurs, photographers, teachers, and students of all ages can participate. Artists are encouraged, but not required, to collaborate with artists in their own or other disciplines. Just follow the guidelines. You may submit up to three entries, however, no more than two images per artist will be chosen for display.

HOW TO SUBMIT:

Please follow all requirements listed below:

1. Send a CD/DVD with the artwork saved as follows:

File Format: JPEG- maximum quality

Size: 12.8 inches wide x 8.8 inches high
(borders are acceptable)

Resolution: 300 dpi. or higher

Print your name and artwork title clearly on the CD/DVD.

2. Mail the CD/DVD and signed release form by May 27, 2010 to:
